**PART ONE: Introduction**

This Publication Scheme is a complete guide to the information routinely made available to the public by, Dr Stewart J. Wright, Dr Roma E. Roberts, Dr Rajesh Sanghani and Dr. Sally Campbell. It is a description of the information about our General Practitioners and Willow Green Surgery which we make publicly available. It will be reviewed at regular intervals and we will monitor its effectiveness.

Class Description: *Details of the practice, organisational structures, key personnel and how we fit into the NHS*

The General Practice organisational structure:

Partners: Dr Stewart J. Wright, Dr Roma E. Roberts, Dr Rajesh Sanghani and Dr. Sally Campbell. Dr Sindy Williams Dr Sarah Pledger and Dr James Relf are employed as salaried General Practitioner. Willow Green Surgery is a training practice and has a GP Registrar. Mrs Sandy Maslen and Mrs Nancy Turner are joint Practice Managers employed on a part time basis. Liz Hedges is employed as a full time Practice Nurse and Elizabeth Monoogian and Cynthia Hinchcliffe are employed as part time Practice Nurses. The Practice also employs two Health Care Assistants and Phlebotomist. Administration staff including Receptionists and Secretarial staff.

The local NHS structure:

Willow Green Surgery is part of NHS West Sussex. The full address is detailed in Part 3.

The Willow Green Surgery provides general medical services for the geographical area of East Preston, Angmering, Kingston Gorse, Rustington and some eastern parts of Littlehampton.

### 3. Financial and funding information

Class Description: *Funding details and charging policies*

Willow Green Surgery receives money from NHS West Sussex according to its contract (as per class 1) in exchange for services provided for patients.

The total amount of income received from the NHS before expenses in 2009 £1,219,144 and in 2010 £1,279,843.

The sum spent on drugs prescribed by the Practice in 2009/10 1,423,272 and in 2010/2011- 1,511,468.

It should be noted that there may be circumstances where material cannot be released because it is confidential or commercial information or the appropriate officer designated for these purposes under the Act has taken the view that it may be prejudicial to the conduct of the Practice's affairs.

### **Cost of Information**

For the most part, we will charge you only for hard copies or copying onto media (e.g. computer disk). Some information is available free, but for others there may be a charge.

Willow Green Surgery will make a reasonable charge for providing information. The charges will vary according to how the information is made available but will include staff time; administration costs; printing or photocopying costs; postage and any other out of pocket expenses incurred by the Practice in the provision of this information. Charges will be advised

upon receipt of the request and must be agreed before the information is provided.

As a general guide, charges are as follows:

1. Via the *General Practice/NHS West Sussex Web Site* – Free of charge, although any charges for Internet Service provider and personal printing costs would have to be met by the individual.  
For those without Internet access, a single print-out as on the website would be available by post from Sandy Maslen or Nancy Turner, Practice Managers, or by personal application at the Willow Green Surgery.  
However, requests for *multiple printouts*, or for archived copies of documents which are no longer accessible or available on the web, may attract a charge for the retrieval.  
We will not provide printouts of other organisation's websites.
2. *Leaflets and brochures* - Free of charge for leaflets or booklets on, for example, services we offer to the public.
3. "*Glossy*" or other bound paper copies, computer disk, video or other mediums, might incur a 'hire' charge which will be passed on.
4. E-mail will be free of charge unless it says otherwise

The charges will be reviewed regularly.
